DRESS CODE:

DIRECTIONS: Take 119 N from Uniontown or 119 S from Connellsville to the Fayette Co. Fairgrounds. Turn onto Pechin Road (a right if coming from Uniontown/left if coming from Connellsville). At about 1 mile, as you pass a cemetery on the left, turn left. Go straight through 2 stop signs. Stay on the curvy road, bearing right at Stefanoe's Printing until you come to Kingan Hill Road, where you will turn left (it is almost to the top of a steep hill). At about 2.5 miles bear right at the bottom of the first steep hill (Furnace Hill). Go about 1 mile, down a 2nd steep hill (Big Falls) and continue until you reach the bike trail. Turn left onto the bike trail & follow signs.
