1843 – First met in a Brick School House located North on 221

May 1846 - First church building was dedicated

1886 - Plans were drawn up for a new church building. Total Cost: \$6,721.46

1888 - The Second Church Building was finished (current location)

March 1911 – Church building destroyed when the boiler exploded

June 1912 - Third and present building was dedicated. Total cost: \$9,000

Bricks for the present building were fired in a kiln just across the creek from here

1992 - 93 Church basement remodeled in preparation for 150th Anniversary

At the 150th Anniversary there were 24 "50 Year Members"

2023 – At this time we have 6 "50 Year Members"
