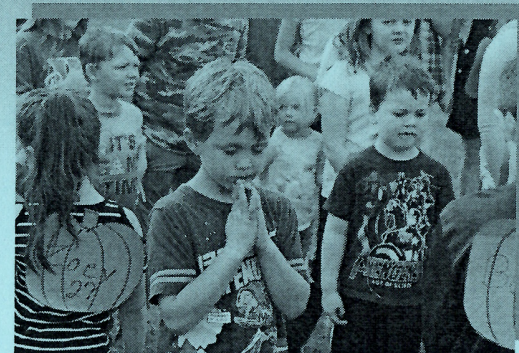
West Sides Youth
